



Announcement of Mahidol University
On Teaching Guidelines for the Final Semester of Academic Year 2020
for First-year Undergraduate Students

Reference is made to the announcement of Mahidol University dated 26th October 2020 on teaching guidelines for the Final Semester of Academic Year 2020 for First-year Undergraduate Students, determined that “The final semester’s teaching will be held as normal.” Due to the current situation of the coronavirus pandemic (COVID-19) and in accordance with the 8th Announcement on the Vigilant measures against the spread of Coronavirus (COVID-19) dated 21st December 2020, Mahidol University would like to announce the teaching guidelines for the Final Semester of Academic year 2020 for First-year undergraduate students in order to prevent and reduce the risk of spreading the coronavirus.

As empowered by the virtue of Section 34 (1) of Mahidol University Act B.E. 2550 (2007) and Article 24 of Mahidol University Regulation on Diploma and Undergraduate Studies B.E. 2552 (2009) and the additional amendment, the President of Mahidol University issues this announcement as follows:

Article 1 The final semester’s teaching will be an online learning or in classroom/laboratory learning. Students can check class schedules on <http://www.student.mahidol.ac.th/portal/> under the topic “News/Announcement” or using the We Mahidol Application.

Article 2 All students are required to follow the preventive measures for the coronavirus pandemic (COVID-19) as determined by the government, such as wearing a surgical mask or a fabric mask at all times, screening body temperature and washing hands with soap or hand sanitizer gel before entering the classroom and laboratory, etc.

This announcement enters into effect from the final semester of academic year 2020 onwards until further notice.
