



## Announcement of Mahidol University

On

### Extension of the Prohibition of Mahidol University Premise Use in Salaya Campus under the Announcement on the Measures to Prevent and Control the Outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) (Omicron Variant) in Nakhon Pathom Province

Reference is made to the Announcement on the Relaxation of the Integrative Measures to Prevent and Control the Outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) of Nakhon Pathom Province (No. 5/2565) dated the 9<sup>th</sup> March 2022 and Mahidol University's Announcement on the Prohibition of Mahidol University Premise Use in Salaya Campus under the Announcement on the Measures to Prevent and Control the Outbreak of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) (Omicron Variant) in Nakhon Pathom Province dated the 23<sup>th</sup> February 2022 outlining measures on academic, research and other activities as well as work from home for staff members, which has been in effect from the 24<sup>th</sup> February – 9<sup>th</sup> March 2022.

Due to the continuous surge of infected cases in several areas, Mahidol University therefore would like all faculties/institutes/colleges, units and divisions in the Office of the President, and Mahidol University Demonstration School (MUIDS) to follow the measures below:

1) All faculties/institutes/colleges, units and divisions in the Office of the President and MUIDS are to extend the measures regarding the prohibition to use Mahidol University's premises in Salaya campus for any activities (Item 1) and work-from-home protocols among staff and personnel (Item 3) as indicated in the above-mentioned Mahidol University Announcement dated the 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2022, until further notice.

2) Only if necessary, activities with participants less than 500 people can be organized, pending approval from Nakhon Pathom province. A formal request is to be submitted by faculties/colleges/institutes/MUIDS and the Office of the President to the Province's Disease Control Committee for permission at Putthamonthon District Office at least 7 days in advance for approval.

Screening tests and measures to prevent the spread of the Coronavirus 2019 (COVID-19) advised by the Ministry of Public Health are to be strictly observed.

Please be advised accordingly. This announcement enters into effect from the 10<sup>th</sup> March 2022 onwards.
